<p>Case Summary: Request for redress against decision to score boats OCS in Race 7</p>
<p>Procedural Matters (including Case type: e.g. Protest, Request for Redress, Reopening request etc) Request for redress against decision of the Race Committee. BRA 109 attended the hearing late. The International Jury was satisfied the hearing had been properly posted and decided to proceed on time under rule 63.3(b). BRA 109 attended after EST 2 made her request and before the Race Officer gave his evidence. The International Jury decided to proceed with the hearing as BRA 109 did not need to hear EST 2's request, being a separate case.</p>
<p>Facts found: EST 2 and BRA 109 were on the course side of the starting line at the starting signal. Flag X was displayed 5 seconds after the starting signal and the sound signal was made by the Race Committee 8 seconds after the starting signal. EST 2 and BRA 109 saw the flag and heard the sound signal. Both boats continued sailing and did not return to start correctly.</p>
<p>Conclusion & Rules: The individual recall signal was displayed promptly, as required by rule 29.1. There was therefore no improper action or omission of the Race Committee. EST 2 and BRA 109 were correctly scored OCS in Race 7.</p>
<p>Decision: Redress denied.</p>
